What will the first day look like?



Tuesday will be a half day throughout School District #22. The first bell is at 8:25 and students will be dismissed at 11:30. Busses will run 3 hours early.

Students will go to their new class on Tuesday. When they/you arrive at school, there will be class lists posted around the school. Your child

needs to look for their grade and then look on the class list. If they don't see their name, they go to the next class list for their grade and look there. Once students find their name on a class list, they can go and play on the playground. When the bell rings, students go to their class list and their teacher will be there to greet them and bring them into the school.

<u>Under no circumstances can parents take a picture of class lists.</u> This is a privacy issue and <u>pictures are not to be taken.</u>

Grade 1 class lists will be located where the Kindergarten students lined up last year. Grade 6 & 7 class lists will be located along the outside bleachers at the side of the school. Grade 2-5 class lists will be posted outside along the Kindergarten classroom windows and into the court yard.

Please refer to the gradual entry schedule that was emailed to Kindergarten families. There is no school for Kindergarten students on Tuesday.

Personal Digital Devices

Ministerial Order No. M89 restricts the use of personal digital devices during the school day. Once students enter the school ground property in the morning, cell phones and smartwatches



must stay in student bags during the school day, unless a student receives permission from an adult at the school to bring their device out. Students can bring their personal digital devices out when the 2:30 bell rings **and** they are outside.



Busing Reminder

Please check out bussing information available on the transportation website https://www.sd22.bc.ca/bus-transportation. The school is not involved in busing registration, so please get in touch with the transportation department directly. We will distribute bus passes to

students during the first week of school. Students will be able to take the bus without their bus pass during the first week or until they are handed out.

If you prefer to pay by cheque or cash, please have your child give the money or cheque to their teacher. Cheques are preferred. School supplies are \$70 for all students.
