Cross Country Running



BX students in grades 1-7 can participate in cross country running. Grade 1 students need to be picked up at BX by a parent and the parent must stay with them at the event. Grade 1's do not ride the bus. All other participants are bussed to each event. We encourage parents to pick up their child at the event and let the coach know at our school table when you leave so we know your child went home safe. We typically leave the school

at around 1:30, the first race starts at around 3:00 and the races are usually finished at around 4:45. More information will come to you in early April via a letter and permission form if your child is interested in participating.

Our primary classrooms will practice during the school day with their Run For Fun program. Our intermediate students will sign up after the break and our coaches will take them along the road going to the BX creek trail for their practices.
